

I have a valid COVID-19 test result which indicates that I tested positive for COVID-19. Does that mean I am now immune?

The CDC has determined that people who have tested positive for COVID-19 do have immunity for 90 days. Therefore, they are not required to quarantine after exposure. However, if symptoms develop in a staff member or student, even those who have previously tested positive for COVID-19, we request that you please notify your school nurse ASAP.

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
