The 2019/2020 school year is in full swing. Mentors and students have settled into consistent schedules and we have welcomed several new mentors to Mitchell and Shapleigh Schools. We have also added many new volunteers into our Kindergarten classrooms where there is a great need during literacy time.

We have three Mitchell students paired with volunteers from the Big Brother/Big Sister program and two Foster Grandparent volunteers who work 15 hours each week. One assists a special education teacher and the other works with special education students, helps out in the lunchroom and also mentors two 2nd graders.

Weekly scheduled mentors and volunteers:

Mitchell School 15 students in grades K-3 have mentors for 1 hour each week
 20 library volunteers for 1 hour each week
 7 classroom helpers for 1-3 hours each week
 2 Foster Grandparents for 5 hours, three days per week

Shapleigh School 10 students in grades 4-8 have mentors for 1 hour each week
 1 reading tutor/mentor/classroom assistant for 4 hours each week

Special Events: Mitchell School

Farmer to School days 2 volunteers for 3 hours each, 1 time per month
Chef to School days 2 volunteers for 3 hours each, 1 time per month

Special Events: Shapleigh School

The Telling Room 4 volunteers this session
The Telling Room Field Trip 2 volunteers for 4 hours each

We have two Traip Academy students volunteering with kindergarten students during afternoon recess, teaching and supervising simple playground games. In addition.

We are looking forward to volunteer help with the upcoming kindergarten registration, Mitchell School Talent Show and the Mitchell Music Night performance.
