Good Tuesday morning Kittery, and Happy St. Patrick's Day.

My communication to you this morning is focused exclusively on the launch of our remote school nutrition program during the school shutdown.

Beginning tomorrow, Wednesday, March 18th, our School Nutrition staff will be providing breakfast and lunch to anyone 18 years and under. The meals are free to everyone, and the menus will be posted on the Kittery School Nutrition Facebook page.

Tomorrow morning, we will deliver breakfast to the three remote sites at 8:00 AM, and we will be there for one hour. Also tomorrow, we will return to the three remote sites at 11:00 AM with lunches and breakfast for Thursday. Again, we will remain there at the remote sites for one hour. After tomorrow and as long as the school shutdown continues, we will be at the three remote meal sites from 11:00 AM to noon each week day to distribute lunch and breakfast for the next morning. The remote site locations are:

- *Kittery Community Center*
- *Woodland Commons*
- *Howard Street (look for the school bus at each site!)*

This is a curbside pickup service. We ask that you remain in your vehicles and pull up near the school bus where the meals will be handed to you. If you are on foot, please keep your distance from our distribution area. One of our School Nutrition professionals will bring your meals to you. If you are unable to go to one of our three remote sites, we will deliver the meals to your home using a 'knock & drop' system.

We want to ensure that we prepare enough meals, so we are asking families who will participate to complete this simple form. The form will also allow you to inform us of any food allergies that we should prepare for. In addition, this form is how we will know if you need your meals delivered to your home.
