A seven week IC3 technology class led to industry recognized certifications and computer skills. It was a team teaching experience with a technology professional and an academic teacher. In April we reopened an afternoon Academic Lab with our new English Language Arts teacher. The lab will continue through the summer. The enrichment classes have been well-attended and plans for the fall brochure are underway.
