2017/2018 is off to a strong start. We have a robust schedule of volunteers and mentors at Mitchell and Shapleigh schools. This year, we lost 2 mentors due to changes in work and school schedules, but we have 4 new mentors so far, and several more who are interested, but not yet finalized. I work with the teachers and guidance counselors to pair students with mentors who are likely to be a good fit. The result is a wonderful friendship between the student and the mentor, which helps the student with their self esteem, their sense of belonging, their study skills, and their social skills. These positive experiences often help students to be more successful at school.

6 library volunteers for 4th grade for an hour each week

2 Traip homework helpers for an hour and a half twice each week

1 parent to make copies for literacy teachers for about 4 hours each week

Shapleigh sports physicals 2 RN volunteers and a parent helper for 3 hours each

Shapleigh picture day/heights & weights 7 volunteers for 5 hours each

Mitchell picture day/heights & weights 10 volunteers for 5 hours each

Mitchell STAR testing 2 morning volunteers, 3 hours each per day for 10 days

2 afternoon volunteers, 2 hours each per day for 10 days

Mitchell flu clinic 1 RN volunteer for 5 hours

Shapleigh Stack-up day 12 volunteers for a total of 20 hours

Mitchell bulletin boards and copying 3 volunteers for 3 hours each

Our volunteers are very generous with their time and their talents. I feel that it's important that we express our appreciation to them, so I make sure to write them each a personal thank you.

I enjoyed meeting many of the new parents at the Shapleigh and Mitchell Open houses, and at the PTA meetings. I look forward to the volunteer expos at Traip and the Community Center.
