Good afternoon...

As promised, I have instructions for those families who want their age-eligible student to receive the COVID-19 vaccine (Pfizer). Students who are 12 years old and older on May 14th are eligible for this vaccine. The Kittery School District and our partners at Northern Light Health believe that the vaccine should be available to all, and we encourage you to participate.

The date of the COVID-19 vaccine clinic is Friday, May 14th. The mobile clinic will begin at **Traip Academy and run from 7:30 to 10:30 AM**. The clinic will then move to **Shapleigh School and run from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM**.

The second dose of the Pfizer vaccine will be administered on Friday, June 4th. More details for the second dose will come later. **To secure a vaccine for your child, please email Northern Light Health at this address: HCHCovid@northernlight.org**

You will receive an automated response explaining what will happen next. That will be followed by an electronic consent form from DocuSign, a confidential platform. The electronic consent form will include:

- *Parent/guardian consent to vaccinate (must be completely ONLY by parent/guardian)*
- *Screening questions*
- *Pfizer vaccine information sheet (VIS)*
- *Insurance information (Although the vaccine is free, there are administrative fees that insurance will cover). Those without insurance will NOT be turned away.*

If you are unable to complete the DocuSign electronic consent form, please call your school nurse who will provide you with a paper version of the form.

Northern Light Health **must receive your email by 5:00 PM Wednesday, May 12th. Electronic Consent Forms through DocuSign must be received by 2:00 PM on Thursday, May 13th.**

Do you have questions about the vaccine clinic? If so, I encourage you to contact your student's school nurse. We look forward to offering this COVID-19 vaccine clinic on Friday, May 14th.
