**RE: Quarterly Report for School Committee**

**January:** Contact tracing has become ever more present. The nurses, PNSY Health Clinic Staff and York Hospital Walk-in Director and KSD School Doctor met to discuss community conditions, protocols, testing and vaccines. One Outbreak meeting occurred with DOE and CDC to discuss KSD mitigation measures. No new recommendations were forthcoming. UNE dental education organized for Mitchell. Wellness notes were shared in lieu of meeting due to nursing workload.

**February:** Contact tracing continues. One case investigation meeting with the CDC occurred. Vaccine strategies for the school explored and discussed with York Hospital and the Maine Immunization Registry. It is apparent that those who work in Maine schools but live in NH will not be allowed vaccination under the Federal Educator guidance. Nurses work to help eligible employees locate and register for vaccination. The nurses attended a Covid-19 Vaccine Seminar and an Infection Control Seminar.

**March:** As contact tracing wanes the focus turns more intensely to helping staff locate and register for vaccines. Kindergarten Registration begins. Nurses gather Covid-19 data for analysis. The York District Quarterly Health Counsel meeting was attended. Nurses attended a seizure webinar. The Wellness policy was reviewed and amended and recommendations give to the nutrition Director. Work on Immunization compliance begins for the new law to take effect on 9/1/21. Contact tracing is beginning to pick up towards the end of the month.
