RE: November Quarterly Report

The 2019/2020 school year is off to a good start. The summer brought a few changes, with students and mentors moving away, but many pairs from last year have returned and have picked up where they left off. Four mentors followed their students from Mitchell to Shapleigh School. Mitchell School has three new mentors and Shapleigh School has 2 new mentors.

We have two Kittery students paired with a "Big" from the Big Brother/Big Sister Program and another in the paperwork stages. We also have 2 foster grandparent volunteers. One works with special education students 15 hours per week and the other is hosting lunch groups 2 days per week and works with special education students one day per week.

Weekly scheduled mentors and volunteers:

Mitchell School:

- 13 students in grades K-3 have mentors for an hour each week.
- 17 library volunteers work for an hour each week.
- 3 classroom volunteers help teachers for 1-3 hours each week.

Shapleigh School:

- 10 students in grades 4 - 8 have mentors for an hour each week
- 4 Telling Room volunteers have tutored students this session.
