To the greatest extent	t possible, I (the
student) proi	mise to:

- Earnestly ask myself the four 'self check' questions every day before arriving to school or before boarding the school bus.
- > Stay away from others if I'm symptomatic.
- Maintain 6-foot physical distancing.
- Wear a face mask at all appropriate times including on the school bus.
- Practice excellent hand hygiene.
- Help to keep shared spaces sanitized.
- Observe signs.
- Comply with all safety rules even outside of school.

To the great extent possible, I (the parent/guardian) promise to:

- Earnestly ask my student the four 'self check' questions every day before he/she arrives to school or boards the school bus.
- > Support the school with its efforts to keep everyone safe.
- Travel only when absolutely necessary and disclose to the school if my student has traveled outside of Maine (exempt states: NH, VT, CT, NJ, NY).
- Drop off things at school for my student during the day only when absolutely necessary.
- Honor the privacy of students who I may see during my student's remote learning experience and be mindful that I am a 'guest' in that classroom.
