RE: Quarterly Report for School Committee

February: A review of the Medication Administration and the Medical Marijuana policies by the nurses was performed and recommendations were given to the Policy Committee. The day-to-day work of managing contagious illness is in full swing as flu season continues. We anticipate contagious illness to continue through to the end of April. Health screenings continue.

March: A Stop the Bleed training was held for 6 staff that volunteered their time. A dental clinic saw 26 students for dental hygiene. A Traip grant was completed for water bottle filling station at Mitchell. Health screenings have resumed following a busy winter season of acute illness. Review of sports physicals occur for spring sports.

April: Kindergarten registration has begun. Health screens are wrapping up. UNE dental hygiene students presented at dental hygiene care to kindergartners. The state immunization report was reviewed and summarized. The Let's Go Survey was completed for Mitchell as part of their wellness activities. Traip grant finalized and submitted for Stop the Bleed training and outfitting of crisis bags.

May: Kindergarten registration continues. Audiology equipment calibrated. Flu clinics scheduled for the next year. Health supply inventory for ordering for the next year completed. The last District Wellness meeting is held for the year. A replacement loaner AED is obtained while waiting for all AEDs to be replaced. This should occur towards the end of 2019. Measles information was given to staff to help guide them towards the need for possible increased immunity. The annual DOE health report is completed and submitted.
