February: Dental health education occurred with UNE dental hygiene students teaching all Mitchell students dental hygiene. Nurses attended "Stop The Bleed" training with a Maine Medical Trauma Surgeon. This is a national training in response to school shootings. The district nurses have become trainers. Health screenings continue. A review of various health policies continues.

March: Updating of sports physical lists for spring sports session completed. Mandated Reporter training completed. There was a dental clinic for the students that signed up at Mitchell School. First Kindergarten registration held for the next school year. Policy revisions submitted. The Wellness policy had been revised last year and is currently awaiting approval. There have been significant changes to the immunization rule for 7th and 12th grades. The revisions have been submitted to the Policy Committee.

Flu Activity: There have been 24 confirmed cases of influenza and 16 cases of influenza-like-illness the past two months. 75 students were sent home the past two months from school for various reasons, but mostly for potentially infectious disease. We hope that these efforts are what is helping to keep flu levels low in our schools.
